

ORDINANCE #58

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE COMPENSATION FOR EACH MEMBER OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ELECTED OR APPOINTED TO OFFICE ON OR AFTER NOVEMBER 5, 1985 AT THE RATE OF \$75.00 PER DULY ADVERTISED GENERAL OR SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS ATTENDED BY SUCH SUPERVISOR; PROVIDING THAT THE TOTAL COMPENSATION RECEIVED BY EACH SUCH SUPERVISOR SHALL NOT EXCEED THE SUM OF \$2,000.00 ANNUALLY; PROVIDING THAT NO SUPERVISOR SHALL BE COMPENSATED FOR ANY SUCH MEETING IN EXCESS OF 26 MEETINGS PER YEAR; PROVIDING THAT SUCH LACK OF COMPENSATION SHALL NOT AFFECT SUCH SUPERVISOR'S DUTY TO ATTEND; PROVIDING THAT THE COMPENSATION SHALL BE PAID MONTHLY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE

BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Milford Township as follows:

WHEREAS, the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania has enacted Act 68 of 1985 setting forth certain guidelines and limitations for the compensation of supervisors of townships of the second class; and

WHEREAS, said act provides that supervisors of townships having a population of 5,000 to 9,999 shall be compensated in an amount not to exceed Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars; and

WHEREAS, the population of Milford Township is approximately 6,300; and

WHEREAS, the General Assembly by said Act 68 authorizes the boards of supervisors of the various townships of the second class to determine the compensation of supervisors subject to the limitations set forth in the act; and

WHEREAS, it is the intention of the Board of Supervisors of Milford Township to set compensation for supervisors on a per meeting basis and within the limitations of Act 68.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

1. Each supervisor of Milford Township elected or appointed to office on or after November 5, 1985 shall receive compensation for attending duly advertised general or special public meetings of the board of supervisors at the rate of Seventy-five (\$75.00) Dollars for meeting attended by such supervisor.

2. No supervisors shall receive annual compensation under this ordinance in excess of the annual statutory limit set by the General Assembly in Act 68 for supervisors of townships within the appropriate population category.

3. No supervisor shall be compensated for attending any meetings of the board of supervisors in excess of twenty-six (26) meetings per year; such lack of compensation shall not negate or in any way affect such supervisor's duty or obligation to attend such uncompensated meetings.

4. Such compensation shall be paid in monthly installments.

5. This ordinance shall be effective January 1, 1986.
